Route 1 On-Ramp (Ramp H), Kittery



Project Highlights

- \$700,000 project - part of \$2.6 million contract
- Awarded to New England Infrastructure of Hudson, MA
- Work includes deck repairs and pavement replacement
- Route 1 On-Ramp will be closed for up to 28 days
- Closure tentatively scheduled to begin September 19, 2022
- Detour route will be signed during closure

This project includes repairs to the Route 1 On-Ramp (Ramp H) Bridge located at Mile 1.60 on the Maine Turnpike in the Town of Kittery.

The work includes pavement and membrane replacement, deck expansion joint modifications and approach work.

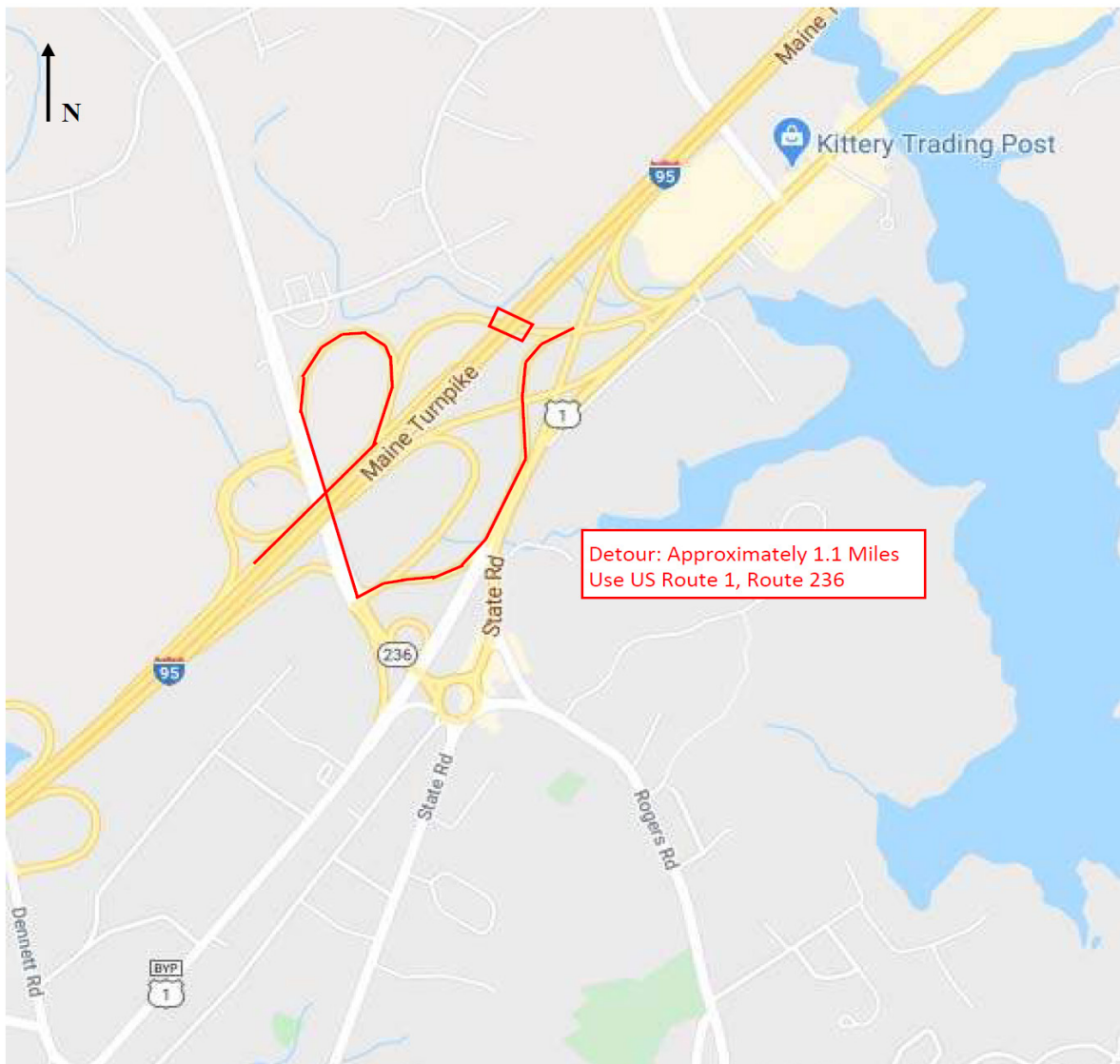
During the construction, crews will be allowed to close the Route 1 On-Ramp for a maximum to 28 consecutive days.

The closure is tentatively scheduled to begin on Monday, September 19, 2022. During the closure a detour route will be signed.

Route 1 On-Ramp (Ramp H) Detour Route



Approximately 4,440 vehicles use the Route 1 On-Ramp daily. Traffic will be routed around the construction site via a detour using US Route 1 and Route 236. The detour as signed is approximately 1.1 miles.
